Pixoroo — How to Sign Up

 This guide is for any Conwy Camera Club member who wants to submit images through Pixoroo — whether for our internal competitions, selecting images for external competitions, one-off events like the annual Creative Challenge, or any future Club projects that use Pixoroo for image upload. It's not compulsory, but if there's a chance you'll want to take part in any of these, it's worth signing up whenever suits you.

1. What is Pixoroo?

Pixoroo is the online platform Conwy Camera Club uses to manage entries for internal competitions — Projected Digital Images (PDIs) and print competitions. It's also used for other Club activities where members upload images, including selecting images for external competitions, the annual Creative Challenge, and any future Club projects.

You create and manage your own Pixoroo account directly with Pixoroo; the Club does not hold or have access to your Pixoroo password.

Once you've entered a competition, Pixoroo sends you an automatic confirmation email for each entry — including a thumbnail — so you always know it's gone through. You can change your entries at any point up to the closing date, and you'll get a fresh confirmation each time you do. Your entries also build into your own personal image library on Pixoroo, and feed into the Club's searchable Library — making it easy for the Club to find images later, including when selecting entries for external competitions, by date, score, author, and more.

2. How Signing Up Works

You can sign up for Pixoroo any time — there's no need to wait for anything to be sent to you. Just use the registration link and the Club's joining code below.

 Registration link: pixoroo.com/public/register/club-member · Club's joining code: E55B4E68C1E5

Please don't share this code outside Conwy Camera Club (for example, in public social media posts) — it identifies our club to Pixoroo.

Once you've registered, your membership will still need to be confirmed by the Competitions Secretary before you can enter competitions or upload images — see below.

3. Step by Step

3A. If You Don't Yet Have a Pixoroo Account

1. Go to the registration link above: pixoroo.com/public/register/club-member
2. Fill in your email address, choose a password (see Password Rules below), and complete the other required details, entering the Club's joining code (above) when prompted.

 Important: when the form asks for Country, select Wales. For Time Zone, select (Dublin, Edinburgh, Lisbon, London).

3. Click Register.
4. Verify your email address. Check your inbox for a message from Pixoroo and click the link inside it. (Check your spam/junk folder if it doesn't appear within a couple of minutes.)

5. Wait for the Competitions Secretary to confirm your membership. This includes setting your competing level. There may be a short delay since it's done manually — no action is needed from you.
6. You're in! Once confirmed, you'll receive a final confirmation email. Log in and click on your Club Entrant profile to reach the Conwy Camera Club competitions portal.

Password rules: at least 8 characters, one capital letter, one special (non-alphanumeric) character, and one digit (0–9).

3B. If You Already Have a Pixoroo Account (e.g. from another club)

You don't need to create a new account — just add Conwy Camera Club to your existing profile:

1. Log in to Pixoroo, then go to My Account → My Profiles.
2. Under the Club Entrant section, click Register, select Conwy Camera Club from the drop-down list, and enter the Club's joining code (above). Click Verify.

As with a new account, the Competitions Secretary will then confirm your membership, and you'll receive a final confirmation email once it's done. After that, log in and click on your Club Entrant profile to reach the Conwy Camera Club competitions portal.

 Pixoroo only allows one club membership per email address. If you're already registered with another club under the same email, you won't be able to add Conwy Camera Club to that account — you'd need to register a new account with a different email address instead. Contact the Competitions Secretary if you're not sure which applies to you.

4. Good to Know

- Your Pixoroo account is entirely your own — the Club cannot access or reset your password; use Pixoroo's own “forgotten password” link if you need to reset it.
- Signing up isn't compulsory, but it's needed for internal competitions, external competition selection, the Creative Challenge, and any future Club projects that use Pixoroo. It's worth doing in advance if there's a chance you'll want to take part in any of these.
